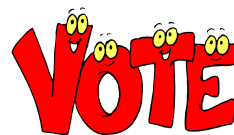

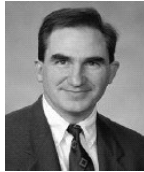

## FROM THE CHAIR

On Thursday, **December 2<sup>nd</sup>**, the 25<sup>th</sup> Legislative District Democrats will have our Reorganization Meeting. This occurs every two years. According to our Bylaws, the Chair of the Pierce County Democratic Party calls a meeting of the newly elected Precinct Committee Officers of the 25<sup>th</sup> LD. At this meeting the Precinct Committee Officers will elect the Chair, the Vice Chair, the two legislative district representatives to the Washington State Democratic Central Committee, and the three representatives to the Pierce County Democratic Central Committee. Following this election by the PCOs, the Chair will appoint the LD Parliamentarian. After this appointment, nominations will be open for the following offices: Treasurer, Secretary, Membership Officer, and Sergeant at Arms. After the election of these officers, the Chair will appoint the Assistant Treasurer, Newsletter Editor, and Webster.

On pages 4-6 of our Bylaws, you will find a description of each of the positions on our Executive Board. Have you ever considered becoming more involved in our organization's leadership? I would be happy to explain the process that will happen at our December 2<sup>nd</sup> meeting.

Our December 2<sup>nd</sup> meeting will also include two other events along with our Reorganization voting. We will be collecting “new” toys at this meeting. Please **everyone**...bring a “new” toy! At the October meeting our guest speaker, in addition to Congressman Smith, was Mike Egan, Director of Corporate Affairs at Microsoft. He spoke on “Inventing the Future” and had the audience laughing, clapping and asking questions. Egan grew up in Puyallup and one of his teachers, our very own Betty Ogden, was in the audience. He spoke of his early employment working for Congressman Norm Dicks, then for Senator Patty Murray and finally moving to Microsoft, working closely with Bill Gates.

Audience members thoroughly enjoyed Egan’s lively presentation.

At the November meeting to be held at the Puyallup Library, our guest speaker will be Nathe Lawver, Chair of Pierce County Democrats.

## 25<sup>th</sup> LD OCTOBER 7<sup>th</sup> MINUTES

Called the meeting to order at 7p.m. Then had Flag Salute, Roll Call of Officers, and Adopted Agenda.

Elected Officials: Ninth<sup>th</sup> Congressional U.S. House Rep. Adam Smith stopped by and spoke. He had been in the area doorbelling. He talked about the policies Congress has passed in the past two years. He and other incumbents, when doorbelling, have to sell the best message. He said that we are moving in a better direction but it takes time to recover.

Puyallup Fair booth report was given by Eric Renz. By all reports we had an attractive, well-received and well-visited booth. We had over 2300 visitors interact with the booth. We had volunteers from most LDs and some campaign teams. There were a total of 64 different volunteers from the 25<sup>th</sup>, 27<sup>th</sup>, 28<sup>th</sup>, 29<sup>th</sup>, and 30<sup>th</sup> LDs and a few who weren't identified and several from the WPEA. The following Democrat organizations and campaigns contributed to the cost of the booth: 27<sup>th</sup> LD \$300, 28<sup>th</sup> LD \$202, Wash State Dems \$1,000, King Co. Central Committee \$210, 30<sup>th</sup> LD \$202, 31<sup>st</sup> LD \$200, Norm Dicks Campaign \$300, Citizens to Elect John Thompson \$100, and Michael Kun, 30<sup>th</sup> LD. So the total amount raised for the cost of the booth was \$2,534.00. The 25<sup>th</sup> Legislative District had contributed the total of \$3,462.41. Because of getting those donations from various organizations really the 25<sup>th</sup> LD only gave a contribution of \$928.41. The following LDs and campaigns who did not contribute were the 2<sup>nd</sup> LD, the 29<sup>th</sup> LD, and the campaigns of Adam Smith, Patty Murray, Suzan DelBene, and Dawn Morrell. At this time we still need to count how many buttons we have, the button cost from the cash intake, after which we will have a booth income figure which will be figured out by October 30<sup>th</sup>.

We will be having our Reorganization meeting at the time of our regular December monthly meeting. We will choose our officers for a two year term.

Our Guest Speaker was Mike Egan. He grew up in the District and thanked some members who were influential to him. He works at Microsoft as the Director of Corporate Affairs/ Political Outreach for the past 12 years. He had worked for Norm Dicks and Patty Murray. He gave us a slide show presentation about the rapid change of communication technology over the years and what technology will be in the future in our homes and offices.

Lona Watts, Campaign Manager for Dawn Morrell, urged us to sign up to help Dawn in her re-election campaign by Doorbelling, Sign Waving, and Phone Banking until the election.

Eric Renz is helping to form a Young Democrat club at Pierce College, Puyallup Campus so if you know any students who go there and would like to get involved you can contact Eric.

We adjourned by 8:30 p.m.



## WASHINGTON STATE DEMOCRATIC CENTRAL COMMITTEE

The fall meeting of the WSDCC was quieter and more unified than I have seen it in recent years as all attendees seemed to have one goal in mind: Elect Democrats across Washington state. During the report by Chair Dwight Pelz, he reminded us that we are in a tough fight to win the hearts and minds of the American people. He said we shouldn't forget the many things the Republicans have done to get us to the situation our economy is in today. They are willing to have the country fail to make the President look bad.

During the financial report Treasurer Habib Habib said people are beginning to understand how important money is to the success of our party. More income has been generated this year. The party is in better financial shape than usual, partly because we now have no debt. This gives us more money to give to candidates.

The Democratic National Central Committee members reported that the aim for 2012 primaries is to have regional clusters of states all vote on the same day.
